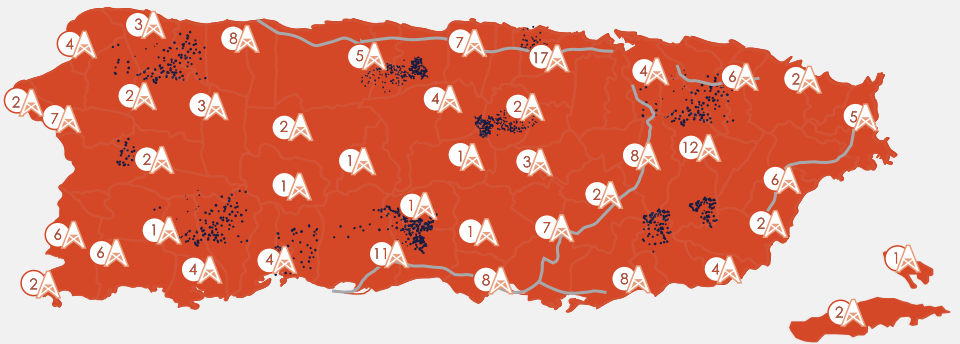
Building a Digital Future

Puerto Rico is harnessing the power of technology to confront some of the most pressing challenges and grow. Driven by local talent, Puerto Rico's tech sector spans digital financial services, AI- and blockchain-based software development, and cyber and information security. This vast and quickly growing scene is supported by island-wide Information & Communications Technology (ICT) and Software Development infrastructure, including 5G rollouts by multiple companies and new 0G networks connecting Puerto Rico devices with international IoT grids.

In Puerto Rico, the thriving blockchain scene showcases innovation. Entrepreneurs benefit from a supportive network and tailored incentives for service exports, digital assets, and financial services. Across sectors like AgTech and health tech, Puerto Rico is poised to lead in global tech innovation.

Puerto Rico aims for universal internet coverage in five years, investing significantly in state and federal funds. The \$40M 21st Century Fund program at universities and other educational institutions will develop digital talent, aiming to add 50,000 people to the digital industry within a decade.

Island-wide Coverage



With 31 Internet providers and three 5G networks, Puerto Rico's ICT infrastructure is competitive. Over 90% is privately owned, and 92% of the population has 4G access, with 63% of 5G device users primarily using 5G.

Cybersecurity
